Public Toilet Songs

For ensemble performance. A number of chairs are upon the stage approximately three feet apart. A performer enters the public space and chooses a chair and sits. The performer begins to enact the vocal noises one makes when voiding the bowels. Other performers enter the public space and perform the same. Orchestrate. Perform until complete. Leave the stage one at a time. May be performed as a solo adventure.

For ensemble performance. A number of chairs are upon the stage approximately three feet apart. A performer enters the public space and chooses a chair. The performer sits. A second performer enters the public space. The first performer begins to enact noises alerting the second performer that there is another person in the public space (coughing, clearing throat etc.). Continue until all chairs are filled and continue to enact noise alerting others that there are others in the public space. Orchestrate. Improvise •. Listen. Exaggerate. For variable duration. Leave the stage one at a time.
